Footnotes

DANCE WITH GABLE steadied at the start, moved up outside leaving the chute, chased outside a rival down the backstretch, came into the lane between horses, took the lead leaving the furlong marker and drew clear to the wire. LUCKY MR. K chased outside a rival down the backstretch and around the turn, rallied between horses in the final furlong and was up for the place at the wire. WARRENS SUMMERGOLD chased the pace inside, remained on the wood through the lane, could not catch the winner in the drive and was outfinished for the place. SHRED THE SECRETS stalked off the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, remained off the rail through the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SHU BIZ DANNY sped to the lead out of the chute, showed the way inside to midstretch and gradually weakened between horses in the final furlong. LIBERAL ARTS was away slowly, chased inside a rival down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, swung out for the drive and lacked the necessary rally. LE' HEAT chased just off the inside down the backstretch, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and did not mount a rally.
