### Footnotes

ACCLAMATION angled in and tracked the leader along the inside, came out a bit on the final turn, took the lead nearing the quarter pole, inched away leaving that turn and drew clear under a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. FALCON ROCK (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, split horses into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. HAIMISH HY settled off the pace a bit off the rail, came out leaving the final turn and into the stretch and was edged for second. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, went outside a foe nearing and on the last turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ALL SAINT sped to the early lead and angled in, pulled on a clear advantage a bit off the rail on the first turn and into the stretch, angled in past the wire the first time and set the pace inside, resisted briefly along the fence when the winner challenged leaving the final turn and weakened in the stretch.
