MISS VEGAS (IRE) sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, responded along the rail when challenged in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. TICKER TAPE (GB) off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the winner past midstretch but could not get by. AMORAMA (FR) stalked the pace along the inside, was boxed in a bit along the fence in midstretch, could not match the top pair but edged a rival for third. WINENDYNME pulled her way between foes to stalk the pace, went three deep leaving the second turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch and was edged for the show. FREAKIN STREAKIN allowed to settle outside the winner, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TAYGETE was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. SAUCEONSID close up tracking the winner a bit off the rail, was between foes leaving the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened, then was vanned off after being unsaddled.
