Footnotes

SHINE'N TIME was reserved in the early stages, moved up to be three deep on the turn, entered the stretch three wide, made the lead in deep stretch and held on for the close decision. PRETTY KINZIE was taken in hand after the start to trail the field down the backstretch and around the turn, swung out for the drive and rallied on the outside in the final furlong to just miss at the wire. THIS TIME BABY pressed the pace from the outside down the backstretch, entered the lane between horses, battled between foes down the stretch and weakened late. ANN'S SEVEN was bumped at the start, moved up inside to take the early lead, maintained the advantage on the inside past the furlong marker and gradually weakened in the final sixteenth. SUCH FORTUNE stalked outside a rival into the turn then between horses on the turn, was asked for her best at the top of the lane and had no response. GOT A PLAN was off slowly and bumped at the start, moved up inside on the backstretch, remained in a contending position on the rail on the turn and was unable to threaten in the stretch drive.
