Footnotes

BENCH POINTS settled off the rail chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, bid three deep past midstretch to gain a short lead and gamely prevailed under urging. RUNFLATOUT came off the rail on the backstretch to stalk the pace, went outside a rival into and on the turn, angled three deep into the stretch, bid between horses past the eighth pole, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. AIN'T NO OTHER bobbled at the start but broke on top, stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid alongside FLIGHTOFALIFETIME on the turn, took a short lead a quarter mile out, drifted out some in upper stretch, angled in while inching clear, battled inside the top pair past midstretch and weakened late but held third. SINAI a half step slow into stride, stalked off the rail, angled in on the turn, waited off heels leaving the turn and came out into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch, came out again and was edged for third. FLIGHTOFALIFETIME pulled his way to the early lead while trying to get out on the backstretch, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail on the turn, fell back and steadied in a bit tight into the stretch, was a bit crowded nearing midstretch and gave way.
