KIZZY'S CHAOS took the early lead and went the opening quarter mile in :24.56, set the pace inside or a bit off the rail, kicked away in the stretch and held under urging. CHURCH SERVICE unhurried and angled in early, settled inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and edged a foe for the place. MEDJOOL stalked a bit off the rail, went between horses into the final turn, came out into the stretch and got up for the show outside foes. STREAM CAT four wide into the first turn, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, came out in upper stretch and was edged for a minor award late. ISIPINGO stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ROMP (ARG) allowed to settle outside a rival, came out on the final turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. POWER BLITZ chased off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep into and on the last turn and weakened in the stretch.
