MISS BELLE O saved ground close up on the backstretch, came off the rail on the turn, angled back inward in upper stretch and rallied along the rail under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. COBRINA sped to the early lead inside, set the pace a bit off the rail, could not contain the winner late but was second best. MINTLY FRESH stalked the pace between horses on the backstretch and outside the winner on the turn, came out some into the stretch and bested the rest. MEAN IMOGENE was sent along off the rail early then pulled her way into a tight spot a half mile out, tried to go between horses on the turn but steadied when in tight again, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. SIXSHOOTER trailed though not far back five wide on the backstretch, continued off the rail into the turn, angled to the fence on the bend and did not rally. NICE DILEMMA was close up stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, dropped back on the bend and gave way.
