CEE'S ELEGANCE bobbled slightly at the start, angled in and dueled outside the runner-up throughout, took a short lead and lugged in a bit in midstretch but gamely prevailed under left handed urging. HAWKSVILLE angled in and dueled on a short lead along the rail, fought back when headed in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. ADDICTED settled off the leaders outside a rival, moved up three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and finished with interest. CLASSICAL CHARM pulled her way along inside early, stalked the leaders a bit off the rail to the stretch and could not offer the needed late response. GETLUCKYSOMETIME also pulled early and was in a bit tight between horses on the first turn, chased a bit off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and did not rally. BANDANGO brushed at the start, chased three deep on the first turn and outside a rival on the backstretch, continued between foes on the second turn and weakened. NEXT LEVEL broke inward and awkwardly and steadied, angled in and saved ground, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and was outrun.
