LIBERIAN FREIGHTER sped to the early lead, pulled a bit under a snug hold setting the pace inside, responded when challenged leaving the second turn, came a bit off the rail in upper stretch, angled back in and inched away in midstretch and proved best under urging. SWIFT WINDS saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and gained the place. CADILLAC (NZ) settled inside then a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and was up for the show outside late. MAN TO MAN angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, continued along the rail in the stretch and was outfinished. PROPAGANDA sent along outside a rival then stalked off the rail, bid alongside the winner leaving the second turn and into the stretch, fell back some in midstretch, was between foes in deep stretch and weakened. CINDER CONE chased three deep then outside a rival to the stretch and did not rally. KALOOKAN BOSS angled in and chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
