Footnotes

MATEO, came off the inside on the backstretch and went outside CLURE, continued outside ASTOR PLACE on the second turn, angled out in upper stretch and closed gamely under urging to get up at the wire. FABULOUS GUY (IRE), angled in and stalked the pace, bid outside LEXICON on the second turn, took a short lead in midstretch and continued gamely but was nailed on the line. CLURE saved ground to the stretch, split rivals past midstretch and finished well. LEXICON, sped between foes to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back in the stretch, then just missed holding third. VOYAGERS QUEST, outside CLURE early, continued a bit off the rail, came out in upper stretch with a mild late bid. ASTOR PLACE (IRE) angled in on the first turn, saved ground thereafter and closed the gap some in the stretch. FLYING WITH EAGLES, three deep early, stalked the pace outside FABULOUS GUY, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. TRES STRICT, off slowly, saved ground, split rivals on the second turn and lacked a rally. ROI GIRONDE (IRE) was a bit crowded after the start, went three deep on the backstretch, angled inward in upper stretch and gave way.
