Footnotes

GOLDEN BALLETT bobbed at the start, sped to the early lead and dueled inside a rival but a bit off the rail early, battled alongside PRETTY 'N SMART leaving the backstretch and on the turn, inched clear while drifting out into the stretch and drew off under a moderate hand ride. STARRER settled off the rail, went three deep with a move forward a half mile out, continued a bit off the inside on the turn and was clearly second best. PRETTY 'N SMART stalked the leaders inside early, bid inside the winner on the backstretch and dueled for command, dropped back some into the stretch and weakened but held third. WARREN'S WHISTLE unhurried off the rail, moved up some outside into and on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. CARSON CITY RED stalked the pace outside a rival early, split horses a half mile out, found the rail for the turn and had nothing left in the stretch. ICANSOIWILL had brief speed outside the winner to duel for the lead, dropped back leaving the backstretch, gave way and was not abused in the stretch.
