Footnotes

DAWN'S ANGEL sped to the early lead outside a rival, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the second turn, inched away again, got clear past midstretch and held gamely under left handed urging. LOVELY RAFAELA saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail past midstretch and surged outside the winner late to just miss. CHURCH EDITOR chased between horses on the first turn and outside on the backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and held third. SWEET LIPS pulled her way between horses and was in tight into the first turn, steadied in tight again leaving that bend, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BROAD MINDED off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out in the stretch and found her best stride late. BILLIARD (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail into the second turn, angled out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHE'S THE GENERAL pulled early, was in a bit tight inside on the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, fell back on the second turn and weakened. NOYAC (IRE) off a bit slowly, moved up four wide on the first turn, stalked outside then bid between horses on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. SOLAR FIRE chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response.
