SELVATICA sped to the early lead, set all the pace just out from the inside and won clear under a moderate hand ride. BULLY BONES stalked three deep then outside a rival leaving the turn and held second. NOSSA CANCAO (BRZ) chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gained the show. DANCING SQUALL unhurried and angled in on the backstretch, went around a rival leaving the turn and into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. SWEET AMBITION chased outside a rival then off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed rally. BABE HALL pulled her way along a bit off the rail then stalked between horses, was in a bit tight off heels into the turn, angled in on the bend and weakened in the stretch. MAZELLA went up inside to stalk the pace, steadied in tight midway on the turn, dropped back, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
