 TRICK SKATE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and proved best under urging. HOLLYWOOD AFFAIR stalked three deep then outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and was second best. STRIKE YOUR FANCY close up tracking the winner a bit off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the turn and held third. SHOW'EM SUSIE settled just off the inside, came out in the drive and just missed the show. MISSILETTE chased between horses, angled in on the turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. LAKE OSCEOLA stalked three deep, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. TORRE ITALIANA broke outward and a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. MISS MARSHA LEE saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and had little left for the drive.
