Footnotes

BRUSHBURN pulled his way along inside chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled out into the stretch, rallied under a tap of the whip and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. DYNAMIC RANGE stalked outside the winner then a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch and final turn, put a head in front leaving that turn, kicked clear toward the inside in the stretch and held second. EL INDY between horses on the first turn, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the final turn, came out some in the stretch and picked up the show. UNIVERSAL PEACE saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the last turn and into the stretch and was outfinished for third. THORONDOR had speed outside then angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and final turn and weakened in the stretch. FAVORITE MEETING three deep on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, angled in leaving the last turn and also weakened in the drive.
