Footnotes

THE GREAT CAPER sent between horses early, stalked off the rail then inside on the turn, came out nearing midstretch, bid alongside a rival, gained the advantage a sixteenth out and held on gamely between foes late under urging. COMMA TO THE TOP a bit slow to begin, pulled between horses and steadied into the turn, angled in and waited off heels midway on the bend, came out nearing the stretch and rallied willingly three deep on the line. BIGMIKEISTHEMAN had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn and into the stretch, lugged in and hit the rail approaching the eighth pole, fought back along the fence in the final furlong and continued willingly. WARREN'S KING KONG steadied in tight between horses early, chased off the rail, angled in entering the turn, continued inside and bested the rest. SUCCESS AGAIN had speed between horses and dueled outside a rival, fell back alongside the winner into the stretch and weakened. GEORGIA'S FRIEND between foes early, stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. JASON wide between foes early, chased off the rail or outside, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. BOURNE TO ROMP four wide between horses early, chased outside then alongside a rival on the turn, split foes into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SECRET TAPIT six wide early, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
