DOULA chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, moved up a bit off the fence on the second turn to gain command and gamely held sway under urging. ASHANINKA settled outside a rival early, moved up outside on the second turn and into the stretch, bid outside the winner in the final furlong but hung late. MISS VALIANT angled in and settled a bit off the rail, continued toward the inside on the second turn and picked up the show. ANNIE BANANIE angled in and saved ground off the pace, split horses on the second turn, continued inside and lacked a late response. CARPA saved ground outrun for six furlongs, went around a foe leaving the second turn and failed to menace. TWOHEARTSBECOMEONE pulled her way inside to duel for command and had the saddle slip on the first turn, opened up on the backstretch, drifted well wide into and on the second turn and gave way. LITTLE ASHLEY settled inside, came out leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and did not rally. EMERALDA dueled outside a rival early, stalked that one off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and gave way.
