Footnotes

CROSSING THE LINE (NZ) was reserved to the second turn, swung out five wide into the stretch, rallied outside down the lane and drew clear late. FIRE BREAK saved ground around both turns, swung out three wide into the lane, took command at the eighth pole and was outfinished in the final yards on the inside. SIR DAVE was taken in hand and outrun to the stretch, swung out for the drive and rallied outside to be a clear third at the wire. NIKKI'SGOLDENSTEED was hustled early to go up and press the pace, took over the lead at the top of the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SARTORIAL angled over to the rail in the first turn, stalked the pacesetters in a good position down the backstretch and around the second turn and had no rally when asked at the top of the lane. RON BOB sped to the early lead, maintained the advantage to the top of the stretch and fell back in the final furlong.
