MASTER CHEF sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back when challenged in the stretch and gamely prevailed under some left handed urging and strong handling. AWESOME INDY stalked the winner off the inside, bid alongside that one in the stretch, battled through the final furlong and continued willingly but could not get by. MAGNIFICENT BLEND close up tracking the pace along the inside throughout, could not offer the necessary late kick but bested the others. BIG BAD LEROYBROWN was in a good position stalking the pace outside then three deep on the backstretch, continued alongside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and was not a threat. RAINGEAR chased a bit off the rail then between horses on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn, also came out some in the stretch and weakened.
