Footnotes

BAD BOY between foes early, angled in and chased inside, split rivals on the turn, came out into the stretch, gained the lead past midstretch, inched away and held under a tap with the whip turned down and confident handling. SKIPPY DUE settled a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and just got the place three deep on the line. INDIANSKI sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside a rival, regained the advantage in the stretch, inched away, fought back toward the inside and continued willingly to the wire. BONJOUR (NZ) chased outside or alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BRINSON a step slow into stride and in a bit tight early, went up inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front into the turn, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. MY MAN SUMO chased outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. ROGUE RIVER stalked a bit off the rail, angled in and dropped back inside on the turn and gave way.
