Footnotes

RIGHTFUL IMAGE chased inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid four wide under left handed urging past the eighth pole, lugged in through the final furlong and edged the runner-up late. CANTONA angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the second turn and into the stretch, bid along the rail in the drive, gained a slim advantage past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. TE RAPA angled in entering the first turn and stalked off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, was three deep between foes past the eighth pole and weakened but held third. DANCING JOY bobbled at the start but broke alertly, sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back between foes past midstretch, then weakened. POINT MUGU angled in and settled outside a rival then inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. HUEGA pulled between horses early and steadied in tight into the first turn, angled in and chased just off the rail, dropped back on the second turn and into the stretch and gave way.
