Footnotes

PINA COLADA (GB) dropped back off the rail early, angled in and saved ground, bid inside into the lane and in midstretch, gained a short lead and inched clear under urging. BOOZIN' SUSAN close up three deep on the backstretch, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch, took a short lead nearing midstretch, could not match the winner late but held second. LADY KATY DID angled in and settled a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and gained the show late. YET ANOTHERNATALIE chased wide on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in outside the winner on the bend, swung out three deep into the stretch and could not quite offer the needed late kick. GLOBAL VISION chased between horses on the backstretch then bid between foes and dueled on the turn but weakened in the final furlong. ANIMA MUNDI (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside and dueled on the turn, battled between horses in midstretch, then also weakened. MONEYMAKINMAMMA broke out a bit, sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled three deep between foes on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. LADY LOU allowed to settle off the rail, lugged out into the turn, dropped back on the bend and had little left.
