EXCELLENT NEWS stalked the pace outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging and strong handling. WENDEN had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and continued willingly but was edged late. TIMEZONE stalked between horses, fell back and angled in on the turn, came out in midstretch and just got the show. FOLK DANCER pulled her way along to press the pace outside the runner-up, dueled through the turn and into the stretch, fought back between foes in the drive and was edged for third. COME TOUCH THE SUN (IRE) broke outward, chased outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. JAWS N' PAWS pulled early, chased off the rail then between horses on the turn, came out three deep into the stretch and also lacked the needed late response. LA NEZ stalked the pace inside, was between horses in midstretch and weakened.
