Footnotes

ICEE CHEASPEAKE stalked the leaders off the rail or outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the turn, gained the advantage in upper stretch and pulled clear under urging. SPLENDID JACLYN had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, battled between horses leaving the turn and to midstretch, then could not match the winner but held second. SHEZA GLADIATOR drifted out early, dueled inside a rival and angled back to the inside, fought back into the stretch and to midstretch but weakened and just held third. CLASS OF GLASS settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, went around a rival into the stretch and just missed the show. STEEP CLIMB allowed to settle outside on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. OURFIRSTATTRACTION a bit slow to begin, close up inside stalking the pace, fell back some on the turn, came out in deep stretch and weakened. SUPER NATURAL settled early, split horses on the backstretch, dropped back into the turn and gave way. MARTINIS ATMIDNITE broke a bit slowly, was pulled up early but walked off.
