TRAFFIC UPDATE stalked inside, waited off heels briefly into the turn, came out into the stretch, took a short lead between foes nearing midstretch, inched away under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. STRENGTH chased between horses then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes past the eighth pole and continued willingly to the wire. CADDYMASTER also chased between horses then outside, went three deep on the turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the show late. LAKE DAYJUR stalked between rivals then bid outside a foe, came out into the stretch, battled three

deep then between foes past the eighth pole and was outfinished. MAMMOTH POWER settled outside, came out six wide into the stretch and improved position. RENEGADE CIELO settled off the rail then inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. BEAU BRIO a bit slow to begin, settled between horses then outside a rival and lacked the needed response in the stretch. CANDY'S BRO sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then angled in, dueled inside on the turn and to midstretch, then weakened. SETH THE CANDEYMAN stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch and turn and weakened. QUIET PERIOD chased outside then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and lacked a rally, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. CURRENCY TRADER stalked outside a rival or between horses then along the inside into and on the turn and weakened. FUTURE SEARCH close up stalking the pace between horses on the backstretch and most of the turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. WILD BEGINNINGS off a bit slowly and steadied in the opening strides, angled in and saved ground to no avail.
