### Footnotes

KINGDOM BOUND had good early speed off the rail, dueled between horses then outside a rival into the stretch, pulled away past midstretch and won clear under left handed urging. JETINTO HOUSTON stumbled at the start, went up inside to press the pace, dueled along the rail, put a head in front into the turn, battled inside the winner until past midstretch, then could not match that one but held second. FLYING HEART bobbled and was squeezed a bit at the start, chased three deep on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for the place. WORLDLY EXCESS a bit slow to begin, had speed outside then dueled three deep, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. EMERALD YVETT bumped at the break, chased between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. GABBY DANCER settled along the inside chasing the leaders, came out a bit into the stretch and was not a threat.
