GOTTA GETCHA chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, angled in entering the stretch, bid inside, gained the lead and inched away, drifted out late under left handed urging and held gamely. GARY JOHN chased a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out leaving the bend and five wide into the stretch, closed willingly to engage the winner in deep stretch but could not get by. TOM WEST chased inside, came out on the turn and into the stretch and gained the show. LAS VEGAS LUCKY stalked the pace outside, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and lacked a rally. LORD ELIJAH settled inside, went outside a rival into the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SOUL WORK between foes early, prompted the pace a bit off the rail then dueled inside on the turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. STORMING BRONX sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, also came between foes into the stretch and weakened.
