Footnotes

HEMET HUMOR sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside and held on gamely under urging. STOP THE HUMOR stalked between foes then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and finished willingly. LIKELY A STAR close up stalking the winner inside, came out in upper stretch and just held third. KULA GIRL off a bit slowly, pulled inside, was in tight off heels into the turn, moved up along the rail in the stretch and just missed the show. TAHITIAN BLUFF broke slowly, settled inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. STEELIN' pulled between horses then chased outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHOCOLATE LAVA chased off the rail then between horses, angled out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. HENNESSY ROSE off a bit slowly, pulled her way along outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. POLYHYMNIA pulled outside rivals on the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. DISTORTED VIEW stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the turn and gave way in the stretch.
