RACKETEER unhurried off the rail to the second turn, swung out four wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. AWESOME GEM between horses early, chased outside a rival, waited a bit between foes on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained a short lead in midstretch, inched away but could not hold off the winner. SALTY HUMOR three deep on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch to loom a threat, could not match the top pair late but bested the rest. SINNERS N SAINTS saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MARSILIO FICINO (CHI) had good early speed and dueled inside then a bit off the rail, put a head in front on the second turn, continued outside a rival leaving that turn and between foes into the stretch and weakened. C'MON TIGER stalked off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch, bid along the fence a quarter mile out and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MR. SPLASH had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, dropped back leaving the second turn and gave way.
