Footnotes

DAYTONA (IRE) angled in and prompted the pace outside the runner-up, took a short lead nearing the sixteenth marker and inched clear under left handed urging. EVER A FRIEND sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, angled in on the first turn and set a pressured pace inside, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late and just held second. HYPERBARIC was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, fell back some outside a rival on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and just missed the place. PERFECT DRIFT saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. MAST TRACK saved ground tracking the leaders, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. THOUSAND WORDS (GB) puled his way along a bit off the rail on the first turn then stalked between horses, continued outside a rival leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. NOTIONAL settled a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, came out in the stretch and was not a threat.
