Footnotes

CALLER ONE had speed inside and pressed the pace along the rail, brushed with FREESPOOL into the turn, took a short advantage on the bend, inched away a quarter mile out, got clear in hand into the stretch and proved best under a moderate hand ride. STORMY JACK settled off the rail, went around a rival on the turn then angled to the inside for the stretch and was second best. RAPIDOUGH broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, settled along the inside, remained inside and picked up the show. GIBSON COUNTY stalked the pace inside on the backstretch, came out nearing the turn, was three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. FREESPOOL broke out a bit but quickly sped to the lead outside the winner, inched away briefly leaving the backstretch, dueled outside that one on the turn and weakened. MATEKA (FR) stalked the pace outside a rival on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, was between horses nearing the stretch and also weakened.
