FLAMETHROWINTEXAN sped to the early lead and angled in, battled outside a rival on the backstretch, kicked clear a bit off the rail on the turn and held gamely under some late urging. HOUR OUTLAW chased off the rail on the backstretch, angled in and moved up on the turn, came out into the stretch and finished well. ORCHID THIEF unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. FIERCE KNIGHT between horses early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail leaving the backstretch, went three deep midway on the turn then angled to the inside into the stretch and weakened. CHESTER'S CHANCE went up inside the winner to press the pace, steadied hard into the turn, dropped back, came out some and had little left in the stretch.
