BELL OF THE YEAR between horses into the first turn, chased off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter and took a short lead on the second turn, inched clear leaving that bend and held on gamely toward the inside under urging. ENDURING GRACE three deep into the first turn, chased outside, moved up on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside the winner past midstretch but could not get by. MAGNIFICENT SUNSET in tight along the inside into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and just held third. ICEMAN MISS veered in at the start, saved ground off the pace, advanced inside on the second turn, steadied into the stretch then got through and just missed the show. MISS WESTCHESTER broke outward, sped to the early lead outside then angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail on the second turn, dropped back and came out a bit leaving that bend and had little left. PURPLE SKY DANCER threw her head in a bit of a slow start, settled off the rail then a bit off the fence, came out into the stretch, gave way readily and was eased.
