**Footnotes**

SEEKING THE HEAT stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid between horses into the stretch, took a short lead outside a rival nearing midstretch and inched clear under urging. O K TOPLESS angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch and again past midstretch and just got the place. LUCK AND FAME a bit awkwardly into stride, stalked between horses then off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch and just lost second. CAILLECH sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail into the stretch and until past midstretch, then weakened. KEYSTONE MALIBU squeezed a bit at the start, saved ground off the pace, swung out leaving the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. LINDA'S IMAGE stalked outside on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
