### Footnotes

STREETS OF HEAVEN saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, bumped with BOULDER CREEK in upper stretch then brushed with that one in midstretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. BIG WAGS had speed between horses then set the pace a bit off the rail on the first turn, dueled inside on the backstretch, inched away on the second turn, got clear in the stretch, could not match the winner but saved the place. FIRE BREAK pulled early and stalked between horses, was in tight in traffic midway on the second turn then steadied between foes a quarter mile out, came out some in the stretch and edged a rival for the show. BOULDER CREEK stalked the pace three deep, came in some and bumped the winner in upper stretch, brushed with that one in midstretch and lost third late. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) four wide into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ADVICE pulled early, came off the rail into the backstretch, angled out on the second turn, steadied in tight between foes a quarter mile out, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. TIZ TRUE five wide into the first turn, angled in and went up outside BIG WAGS to press the pace, dropped back off the rail then between horses on the second turn and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run between the winner and BOULDER CREEK but made no change when they ruled the contact between those two was initiated by the latter.
