Footnotes

RIBOLETTA (BRZ) dueled along the inside, gained a short advantage on the backstretch, inched away on the second turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and drew clear under a crack of the whip and a strong hand ride. BORDELAISE (ARG) bobbed slightly at the start, forced the early pace between foes, took back leaving the first turn and stalked the dueling leaders a bit off the rail, moved up three deep on the second turn, could not catch the winner but was second best. EXCELLENT MEETING saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the second turn, was taken out off the rail in midstretch and just held third. SPEAKING OF TIME unhurried outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, moved up some into the stretch, came out nearing midstretch and just missed the show. SMOOTH PLAYER four wide into the first turn, dueled three deep on that turn and backstretch, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened. SPANISH FERN three deep into the first turn, dueled between horses to the second turn, then also dropped back on that bend and gave way.
