### Footnotes

BEAR IN THE WOODS chased outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and into the stretch and rallied under some urging and good handling to prove best. AFFIRMATIVE moved up inside on the backstretch, was in a bit tight then bid along the rail on the turn, gained the lead in the stretch, kicked clear and just held second. TONITRUANT stalked the pace a bit off the rail then inside, came out in upper stretch and just missed the place. LAZZERI between horses early, chased off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. CRIMSON CAPER stalked outside on the backstretch and alongside a rival on the turn, found the rail into the stretch and also lacked the necessary rally. SLOW N EASY unhurried off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out on the turn and into the stretch, then drifted in and out and was not a threat. SNATCH THE CASH stalked outside, went four wide midway on the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. RAKE'S PROGRESS between foes early, stalked off the rail, bid three deep nearing midway on the turn, dropped back in the stretch and also weakened. NO AGGRAVATION broke a bit in the air and a bit slowly, went up between horses on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and had little left. BATTLE RED sped to the early lead off the rail, was between foes early on the turn, dueled outside the runner-up on the bend and dropped back steadily in the stretch.
