**Footnotes**

KILLER BEAR chased outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up on the wire. ADAM SUANCES broke outward, raced wide early then stalked outside, went four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch, drifted in and bid alongside a rival to take the lead past the eighth pole and was caught between foes late. ONE MAN'S DELIGHT saved ground stalking the pace, bid along the rail to gain a slim advantage leaving the backstretch, dueled inside on the turn, inched away in the stretch, fought back in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. SCOTFIELD BARRACKS broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch, came out three deep into the stretch and improved position. ITSSULTRYINTHECAPE stalked between horses then off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and lacked the needed late kick. J P JAMMER bobbled at the start, raced wide early then stalked three deep, bid three wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. ROMAN COUNSEL chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and did not rally. WAIVE LIABILITY pulled some when a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. MALONE SLAM saved ground chasing the pace and weakened in the stretch. SENATOR BOB sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then dueled outside a rival, battled between horses on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
