JOE CARL angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, angled out again in upper stretch and rallied under a left handed crack of the whip and strong handling to get up on the wire while brushing with STRAIGHTMIDNIGHT late. RIVERGRADE BOY sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn, turned back a bid in upper stretch, drifted out despite right handed pressure in the final furlong and was caught late. STRAIGHTMIDNIGHT three deep into the first turn, chased just off the rail, came out three wide into the stretch, rallied between horses in deep stretch and steadied in tight between the top pair while brushing with the winner on the line. MR. SATURDAYNIGHT broke out a bit, was between horses early, stalked outside a rival on the first turn then off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SCORED four wide into the first turn, chased off the inside, swung three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARRENS ATTACK CAT pulled inside and steadied off heels into the first turn, tugged his way along to bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch, dropped back leaving the second turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
