Footnotes

OLD TRIESTE sped to the early lead, led throughout off the rail and drew off in the stretch under a crack of the whip and a steady hand ride. BUDROYALE, stalked the winner off the rail throughout, was no match for that one in the stretch but was clearly second best. PUERTO MADERO (CHI) three deep on the first turn, angled to the rail on the backstretch, moved up on the second turn, went around CLOVER HUNTER a quarter mile out, angled back to the fence and picked up the show. MOORE'S FLAT, settled a bit off the rail to the stretch and improved position. HAL'S PAL (GB) came off the rail on the first turn, chased between horses on the backstretch and weakened. CLOVER HUNTER, a bit crowded after the start, angled in leaving the first turn, inched forward approaching the second turn, remained inside and came up empty. SELF FEEDER (IRE), outside HAL'S PAL early, stalked three deep on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and lacked a further response.
