Footnotes

COLLALTO broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, moved up inside leaving the turn, swung three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to be along in time. MINNIE'S BOY bumped at the break, angled in and stalked inside, bid along the rail on the turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch but was caught late. FIERY REBEL stalked the pace inside, came out a bit for room in deep stretch and continued willingly. LEAVIN IN A LIMO chased between horses then outside, came four wide into the stretch and just missed the show. IZEMINE broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and improved position but was not a threat. COLD RULER settled off the rail, angled in some for the turn, came out in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SHARK CITY stalked between horses then three deep, bid three wide on the turn and into the stretch, lugged in a bit in midstretch and weakened. DENIZEN sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled between horses on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DISRUPTIVINFLUENCE settled between foes then outside, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. BROTHER ALBERT broke out, bumped the runner-up and steadied at the start, pulled his way between horses to stalk the pace, dropped back on the turn and weakened. RYLAND allowed to settle off the rail, dropped back outside a rival leaving the backstretch and lacked a further response. TRADE MASTER stalked the pace four wide, dropped back outside on the turn, angled in some in the stretch and weakened. VICAR'S WALK chased off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
