TRAVEL SQUAD pulled a bit and stalked inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter under left handed urging then had the rider lose the whip past the eighth pole, took a short advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and held on gamely between foes late. BATTLE SCHOOL pulled his way between horses stalking the pace, continued just off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and went willingly between rivals late. ROYAL F J stalked three deep to the stretch and also went on willingly between rivals on the wire. HOG'S HOLLOW three deep on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also finished with interest. ROYAL DREAM sped to the early lead, tugged his way along to set the pace inside, fought back in the stretch and was outfinished late. BEACHROCK stalked the pace inside, steadied briefly into the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DONTMESROUNDWITJIM pulled between horses then chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also could not offer the necessary late kick. UTOPIAN broke slowly, settled inside then outside a rival, continued just off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. WASH PARK pulled a bit and stalked the pace outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. COLONEL MUSTARD broke slowly, angled in outside a rival then settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a factor. SLEW LIKE SYMPTOMS four wide into the first turn, angled in and settled inside into the backstretch, saved ground off the pace and did not menace.
