Footnotes

LILY AMORE angled in and dueled inside, fought back through a long drive and gamely prevailed under urging. THREE CUTIES prompted the pace between horses then outside the winner on the turn, also fought back through the stretch and continued willingly while just holding second. LIMERICK LANE

chased between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, continued off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and held third. KALK BAY broke a bit slowly and steadied slightly at the gap to drop back, settled off the rail, moved up inside leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch and finished well between foes late. WHISKERS AND RYE chased off the rail, was in tight off heels a half mile out, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S GENIUS chased five wide then outside leaving the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. CONFECTIONIST close up stalking the pace four wide, fell back outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. SARATOGA LOV unhurried inside on the backstretch and into the turn, split rivals leaving the bend, continued inside and was not a threat. GOLDEN TRANQUILITY chased outside or off the rail, steadied off heels into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. DAWNGONEGOLD chased between horses, was shuffled back into the turn and weakened. QUEEN'S DANCE broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, was in tight a half mile out and did not rally. WAKEUPLITTLESUSIE prompted the pace between horses then stalked three deep on the turn, dropped back in the stretch and gave way. WHOLE ENCHILADA wide early, chased outside, also dropped back on the turn and in the stretch and gave way.
