JUDGE JOAN between horses early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the turn, bid alongside the pacesetter in the stretch, took the lead past the eighth pole, kicked clear under urging and held. MONA STORM stalked the pace outside or off the rail, continued alongside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was second best. MAGICROOY saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the turn and in the stretch to gain the show. STUNNINGLY settled between horses then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, came out in the stretch and was outfinished for third. LADY

LAZER broke out a bit, had good early speed and set the pace off the rail, angled in on the turn, fought back briefly in midstretch, then weakened. SPARROW went up inside to stalk the pace along the rail on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. GUIDED REWARD in a bit tight early, angled in and settled inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. WHAT'S THE PRIZE chased off the rail then between foes, angled in on the turn and lacked the needed rally. BILLSSECONDCHANCE settled outside, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. LED ADVANTAGE broke a bit slowly, settled inside then just off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. BALLERINA ANGEL chased outside or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. VERY VINTAGE was in a good position stalking the pace toward the inside, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened. WARREN'S WHISPER wide in the opening stages, settled outside, angled in on the turn and was not a factor.
