Footnotes

LIGHTEN UP TINY squeezed a bit at the start, raced unhurried off the rail and climbing early, continued off the inside on the turn and four wide into the stretch, then put in a strong late surge under some urging to get up late. HEAVEN CAME DOWN sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, remained clear in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. THE DR. IS A LADY came off the rail and stalked the leader to the stretch, then lacked the needed response but held third. METEOR GAME shuffled back from between horses at the start, settled off the rail and improved position but was not a threat. OUR HERE TIZ angled in unhurried in the backstretch, came out midway on the turn and three deep into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip nearing the sixteenth pole, then drifted in. LADY DI HUNTLEY close up stalking the pace along the inside to the stretch, weakened. HYBABY settled off the rail early then went up three deep into and on the turn to chase the leader, angled in a bit leaving the bend and also weakened. PURE IN EXCESS stalked the pace outside a rival early then between horses into and on the turn and had little left in the stretch.
