Footnotes

REPO dueled inside, inched away some while drifting out nearing midstretch, drifted inward past midstretch and held on gamely under some left handed urging and strong handling. SOUTHERN FIREBALL between horses early, stalked inside, bid along the rail in the drive, steadied in tight between the winner and the fence nearing the sixteenth pole, came out some and finished willingly. GOT AN ITCH chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and continued gamely between foes on the line. WASHINGTON BRIDGE settled outside a rival chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and rallied four wide on the wire. COME HOME QUICK had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn and weakened some in the final furlong. PINCELADA four wide early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, lugged in some off heels in midstretch and lacked the needed response. FIVE SILVER STARS settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out some into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. Following a stewards' inquiry, REPO was disqualified and placed second for interference past midstretch.
