AMAZOMBIE stalked the pace inside, came out under left handed urging and bulled through between foes bumping with M ONE RIFLE in midstretch, rallied to the front just inside the sixteenth pole and held on gamely. CAMP VICTORY was in a good position four wide early, stalked outside or off the rail, continued three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, was bumped in midstretch, bid willingly outside AMAZOMBIE in deep stretch but could not get by. M ONE RIFLE close up three deep early, stalked the pace a bit off the rail, came out three wide into the stretch, was bumped between horses in midstretch and edged INDIAN FIREWATER for third. INDIAN FIREWATER between horses early, angled in and dueled inside on the backstretch and turn, fought back in the stretch, put a head in front a sixteenth from the wire and was outfinished. COST OF FREEDOM sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in and dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn and into the stretch, battled between horses in deep stretch and weakened late. GATO GO WIN was a bit awkwardly into stride but broke alertly, dropped back outside then off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground off the pace, came out in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. Following a stewards' inquiry, AMAZOMBIE was disqualified and placed third for interference in midstretch.
