MODEST MAN sped to the early lead and angled in, set all the pace along the rail and held on gamely under urging. ALOTTA NUMBERS was in a good position chasing the winner three deep to the stretch, could not catch that one but gamely took the place. KILLER KANE came off the rail early and settled outside a rival, went three deep into the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid. FUN AND SUN wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, was between horses past midstretch and lacked the needed response. PEANUT BUTTER MAN between horses early, angled in and saved ground chasing the winner and also could not offer the necessary late kick. PRIZED GEM angled in early and saved ground in midpack, came a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and did not rally. DOLE in a bit tight off heels early, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. NASHVILLE CAT angled in and chased the winner outside a rival, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. REAL GRANDE unhurried off the inside early, remained off the rail and failed to respond. PLEASANTLY PERFECT off a half step slowly, angled in and saved ground but was outrun and was eased.
