Footnotes

JOEY FRANCO stalked four wide on the backstretch, moved up three deep into the turn, bid outside the leader on the bend, gained command nearing the stretch, kicked clear and held while drifting in under urging. KELA tracked the leader off the rail on the backstretch and between horses on the turn, continued willingly off the rail in the stretch but could not catch the winner. PUBLICATION a bit awkwardly into stride, saved ground off the pace, remained inside and rallied along the rail for third. CRAFTY C. T. off a bit slowly, angled in and stalked the pace inside, fell back a bit on the turn, came out in upper stretch and just missed the show. CAPPUCHINO sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled inside the winner leaving the turn, drifted out late and weakened. JIMMY Z allowed to settle off the rail without early speed, continued off the fence on the turn, came out in the stretch and did not rally. GOLDEN HARE close up stalking the pace between horses on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, also came out in the stretch and weakened. A claim of foul by the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference on the far turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to substantiate the claim.
