EVENING JEWEL took the early lead outside a rival, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, turned back the bid of ANDINA in upper stretch to inch away again and held on gamely under urging. COZI ROSIE stalked inside, tugged her way up along the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and closed willingly to just miss. CITY TO CITY chased inside then came off the rail into the backstretch, angled back in and saved ground, came out in upper stretch and finished well. TRIPLE CREAM close up tracking the leader along the inside throughout, continued willingly in the stretch to share fourth. ANDINA (IRE) stalked the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the winner on the second turn and into the stretch, was between foes past midstretch and weakened some. IN THE SLIPS chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, went between foes on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DREAMED TO DREAM allowed to settle outside a rival then off the rail, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response.
